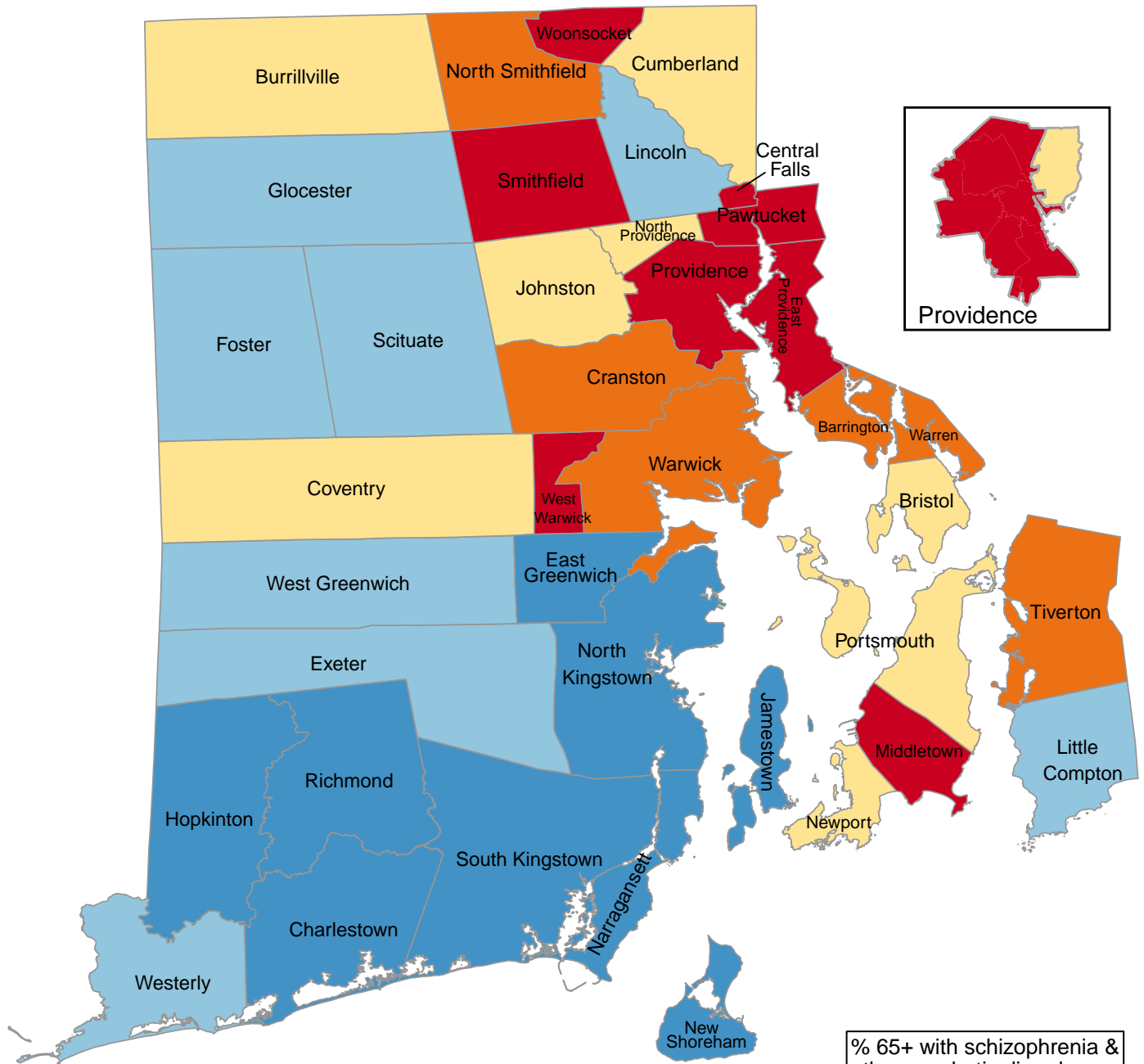


Percentage of Medicare Beneficiaries Age 65+ Years with Schizophrenia and Other Psychotic Disorder



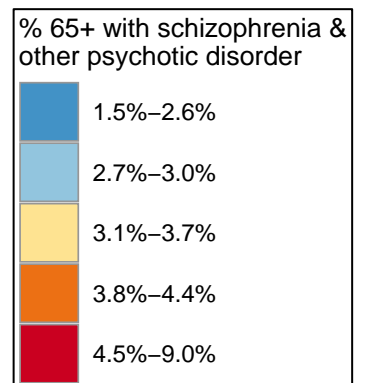
