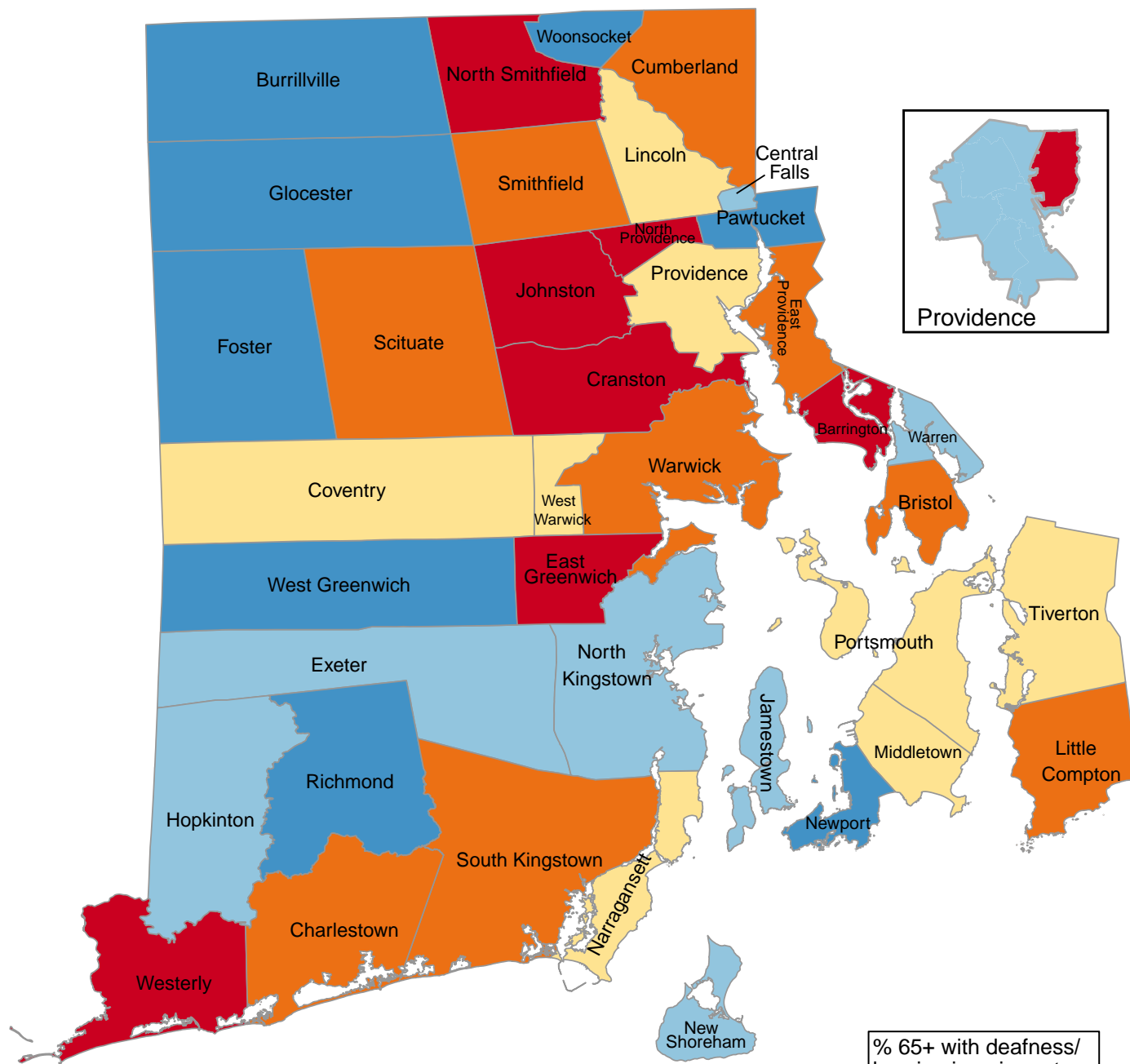


Percentage of Medicare Beneficiaries Age 65+ Years with Deafness or Hearing Impairment



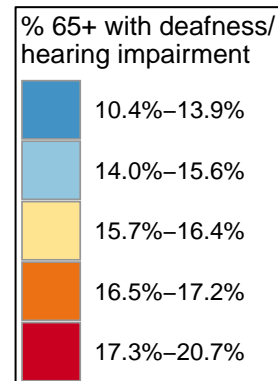
