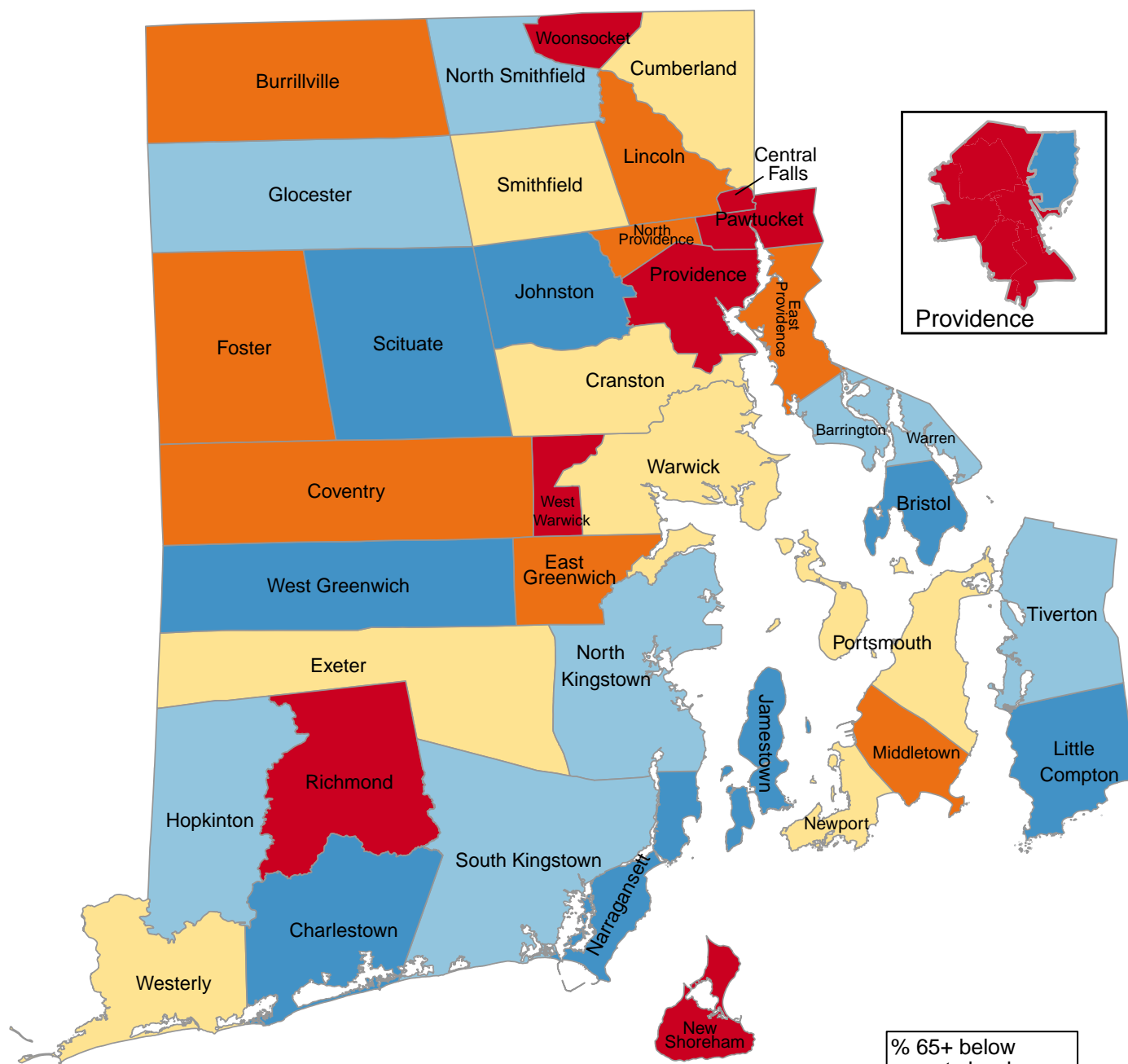


Percentage of Population Age 65+ Years with Income Below the Poverty Level in the Last Year



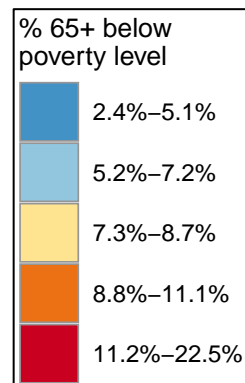
