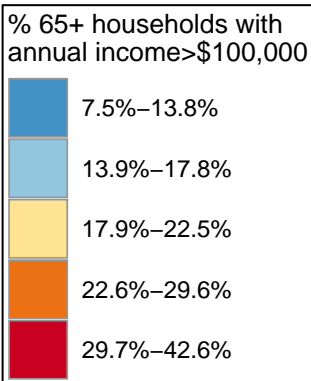
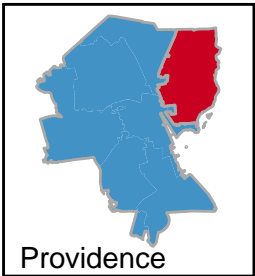
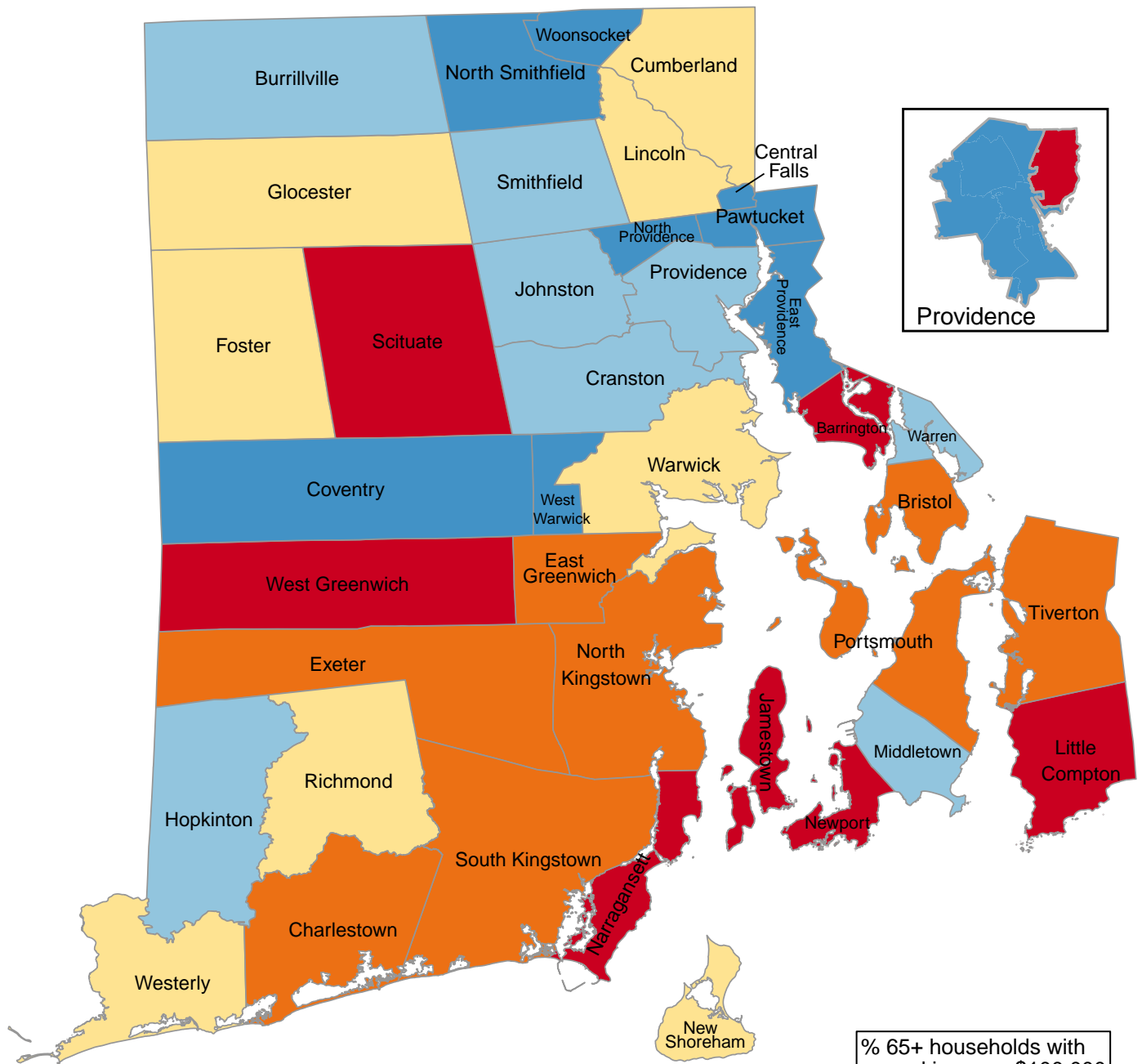


Percentage of Households with a Householder Age 65+ Years with Annual Income Above \$100,000
