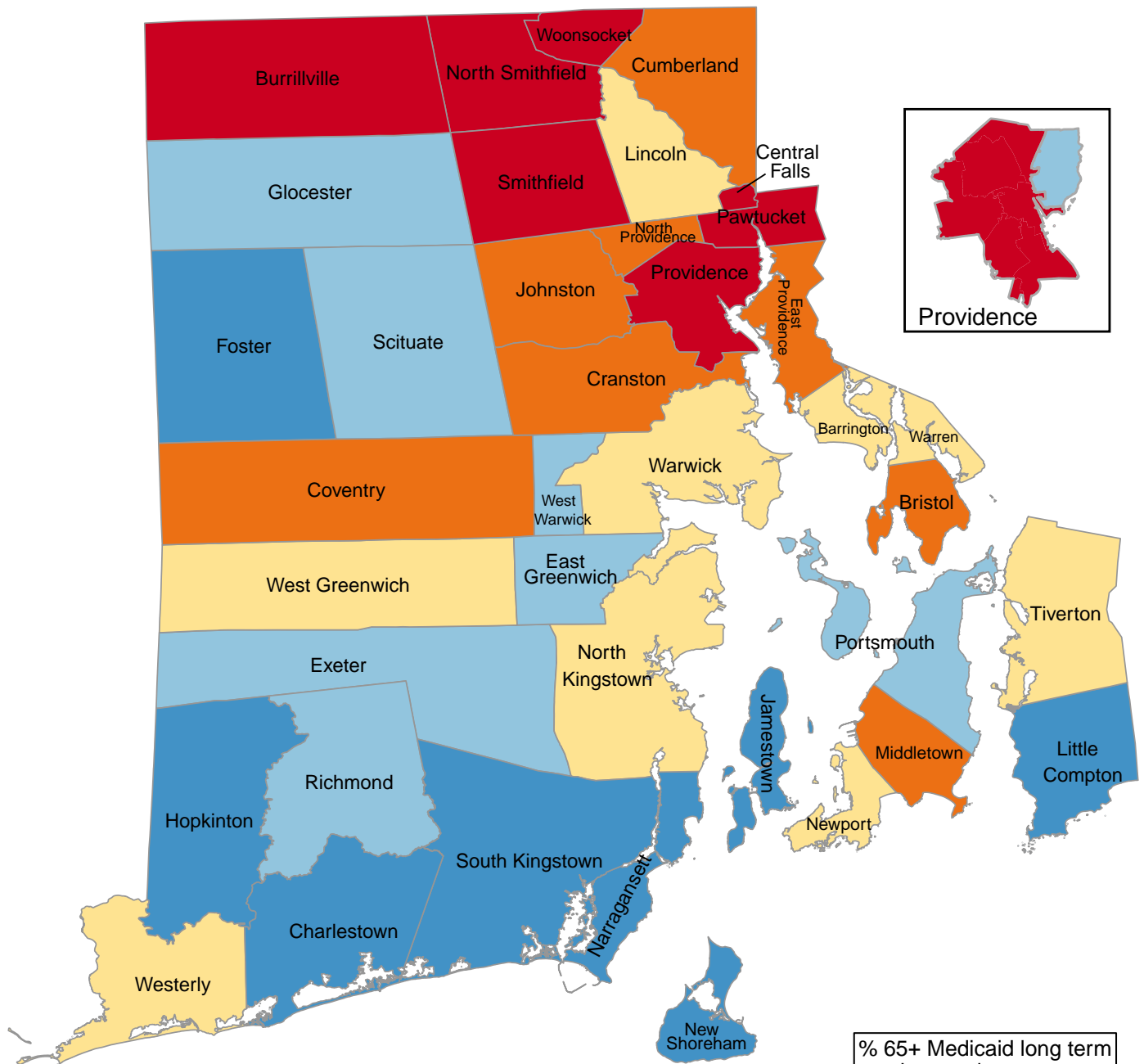


Percentage of Medicare Beneficiaries Age 65+ Years Getting Medicaid Long Term Services and Supports



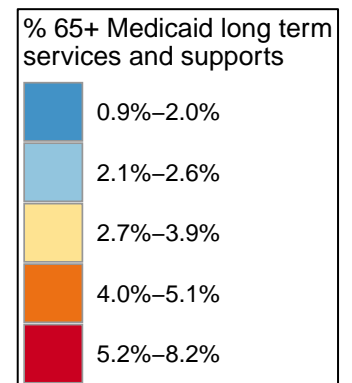
