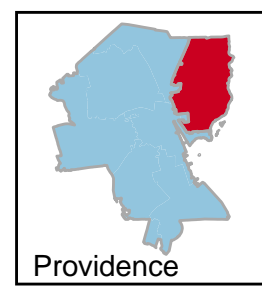
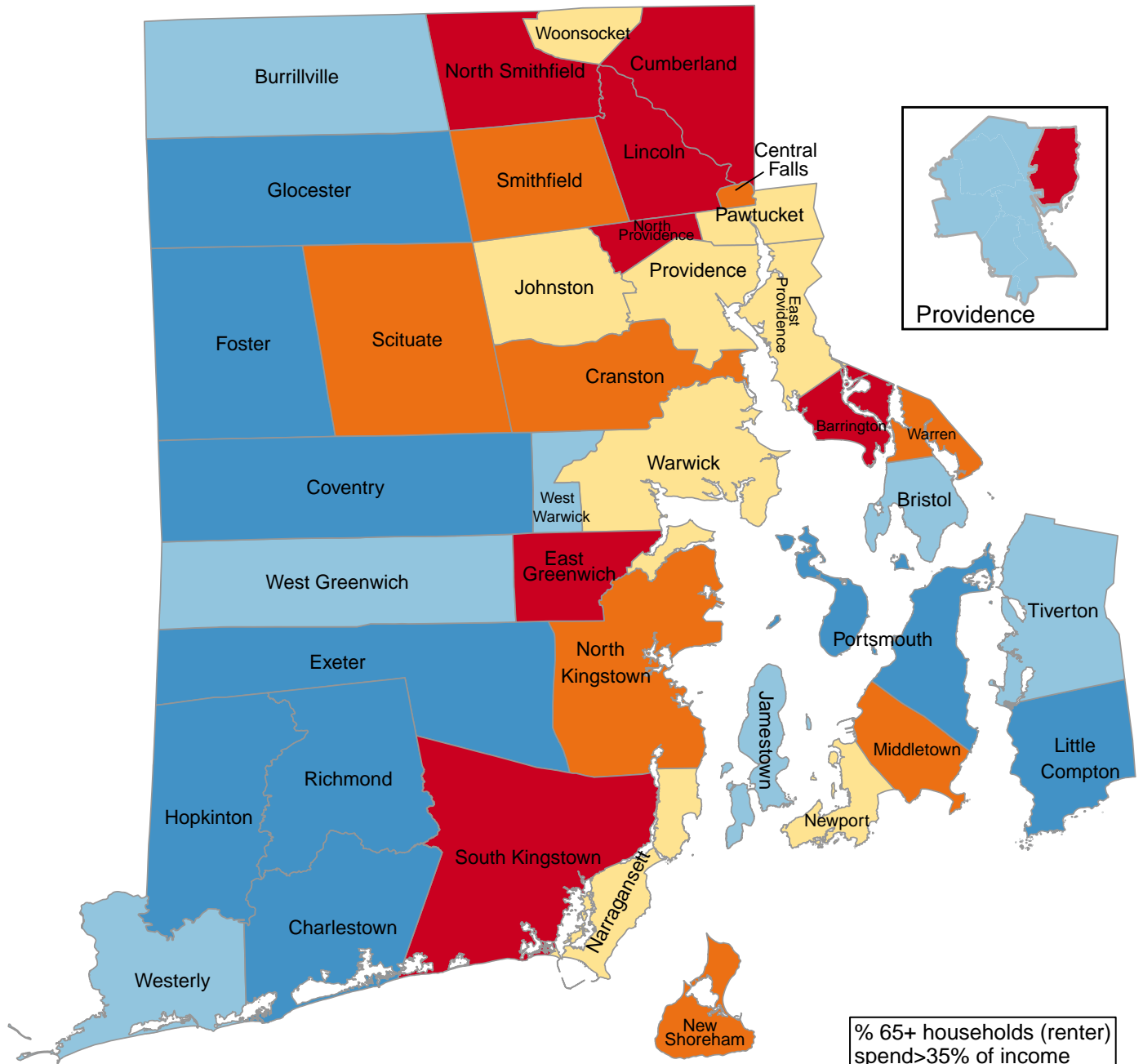


Percentage of Householders Age 65+ Years Spend More than 35% of Income on Housing (Renters)



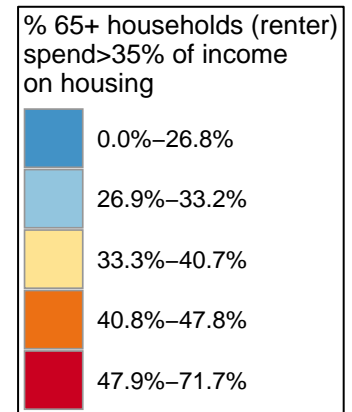
