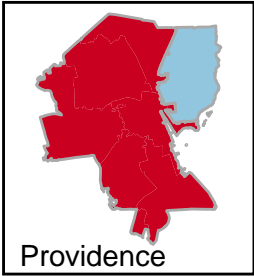
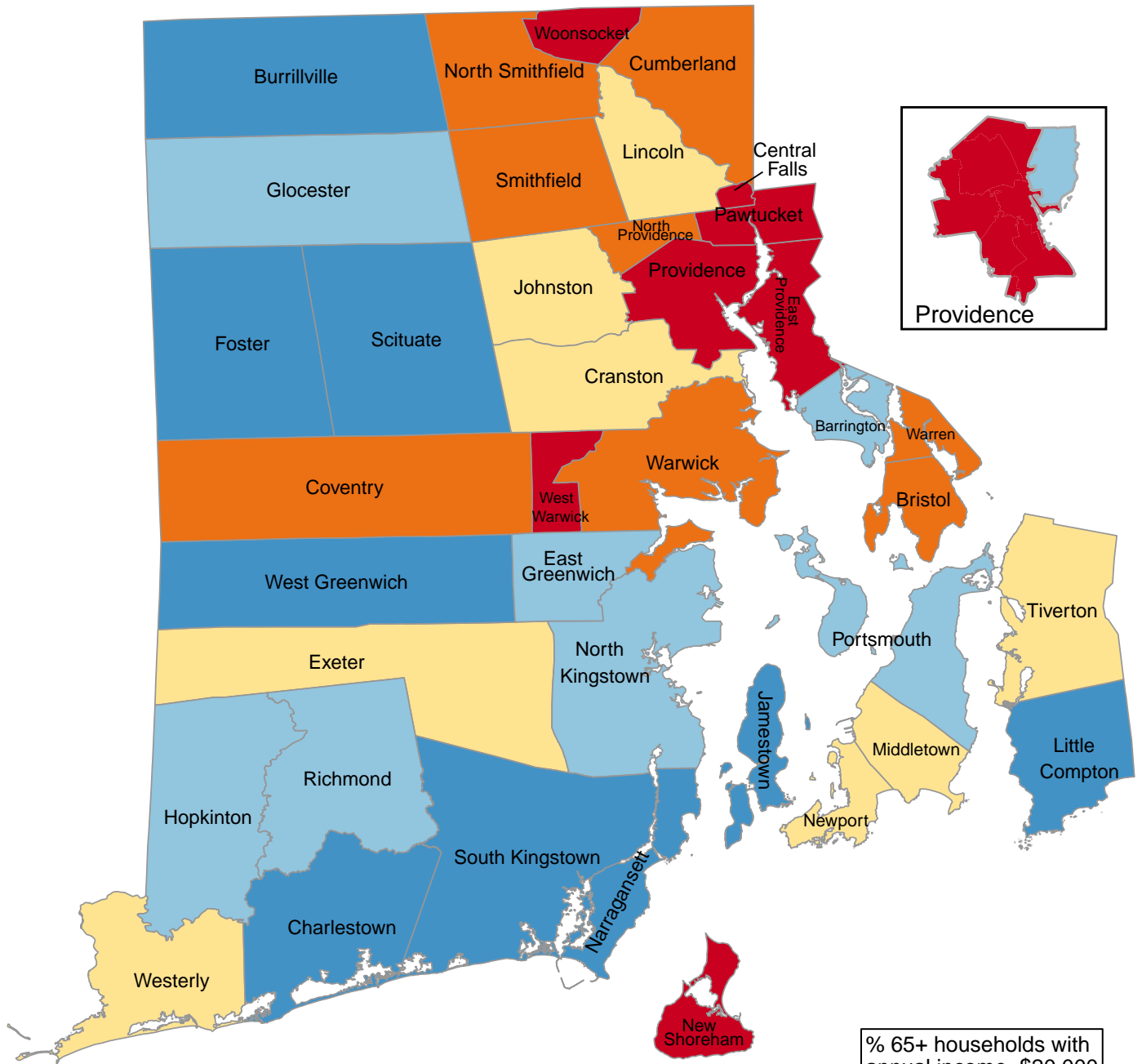


Percentage of Households with a Householder Age 65+ Years with Annual Income Less than \$20,000



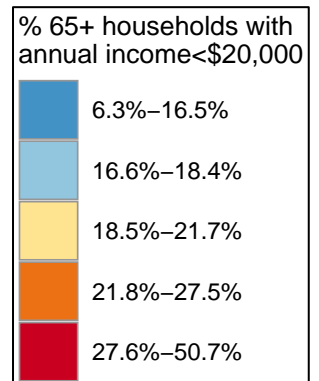
