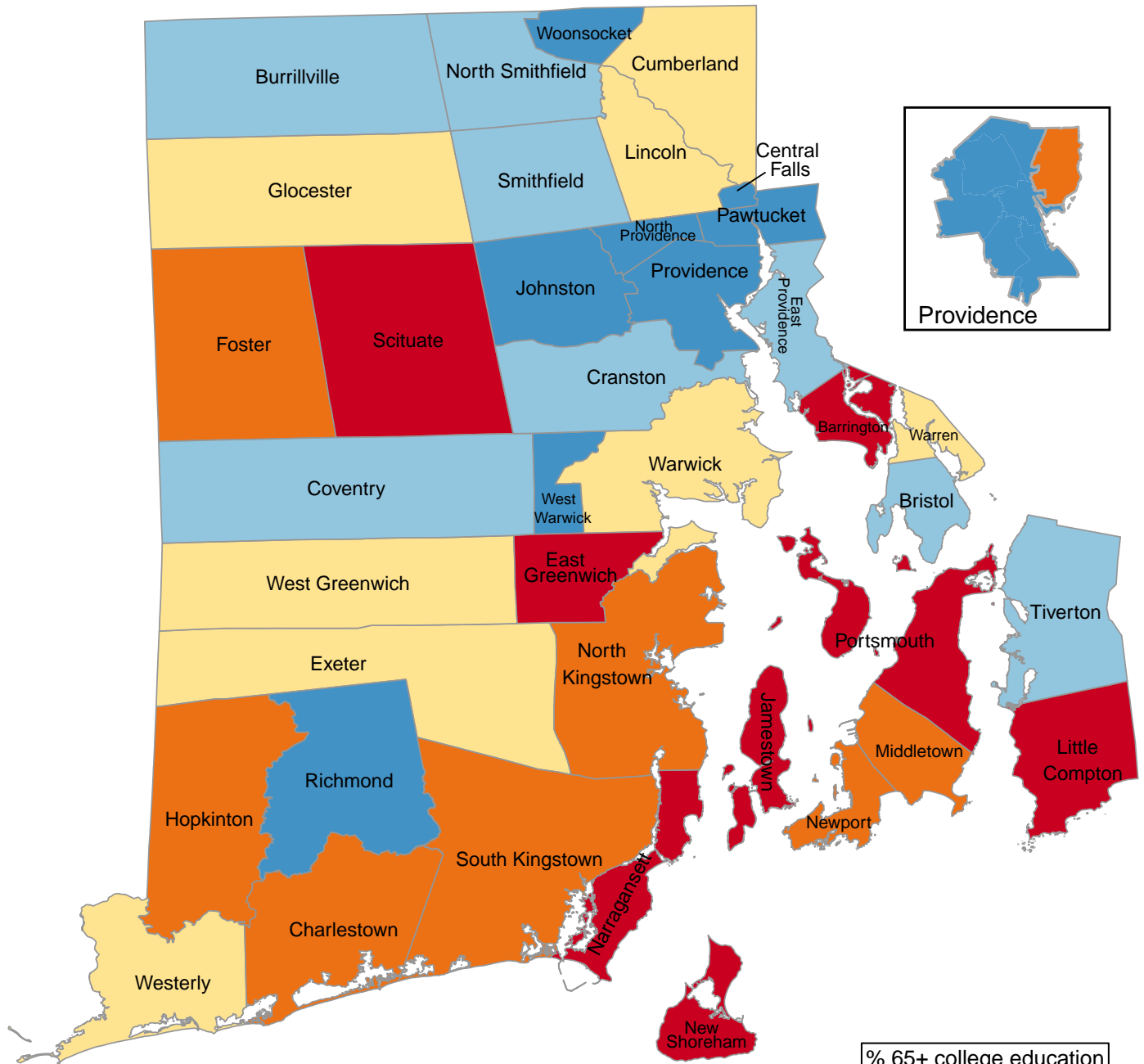


Percentage of Population Age 65+ Years College Education



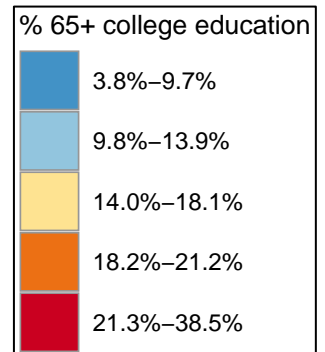
