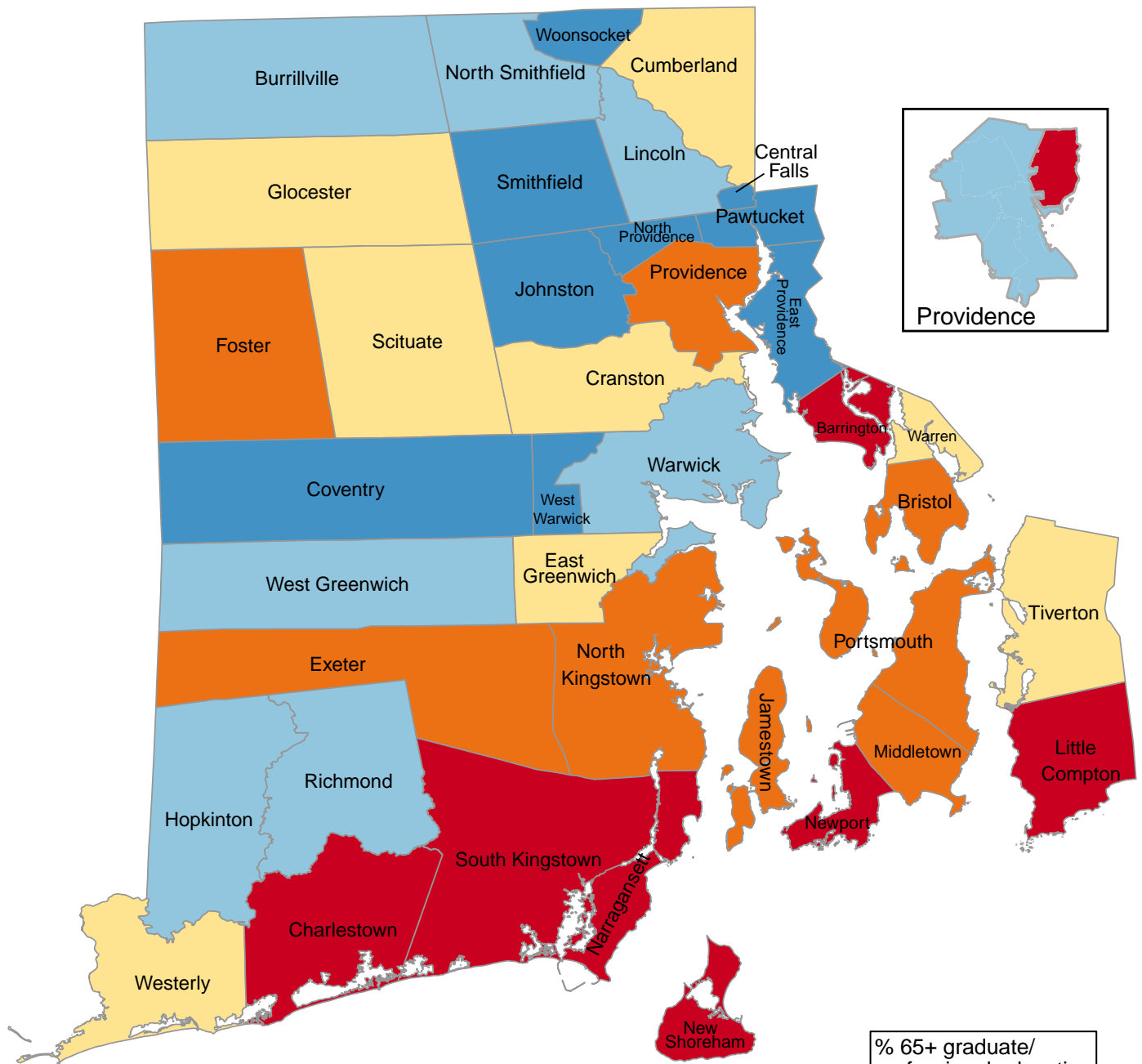


## Percentage of Population Age 65+ Years Graduate or Professional Education



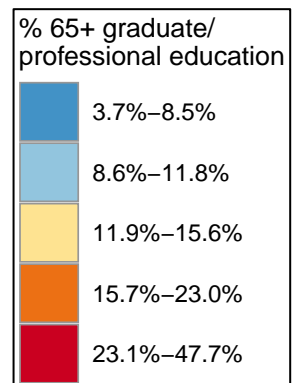
