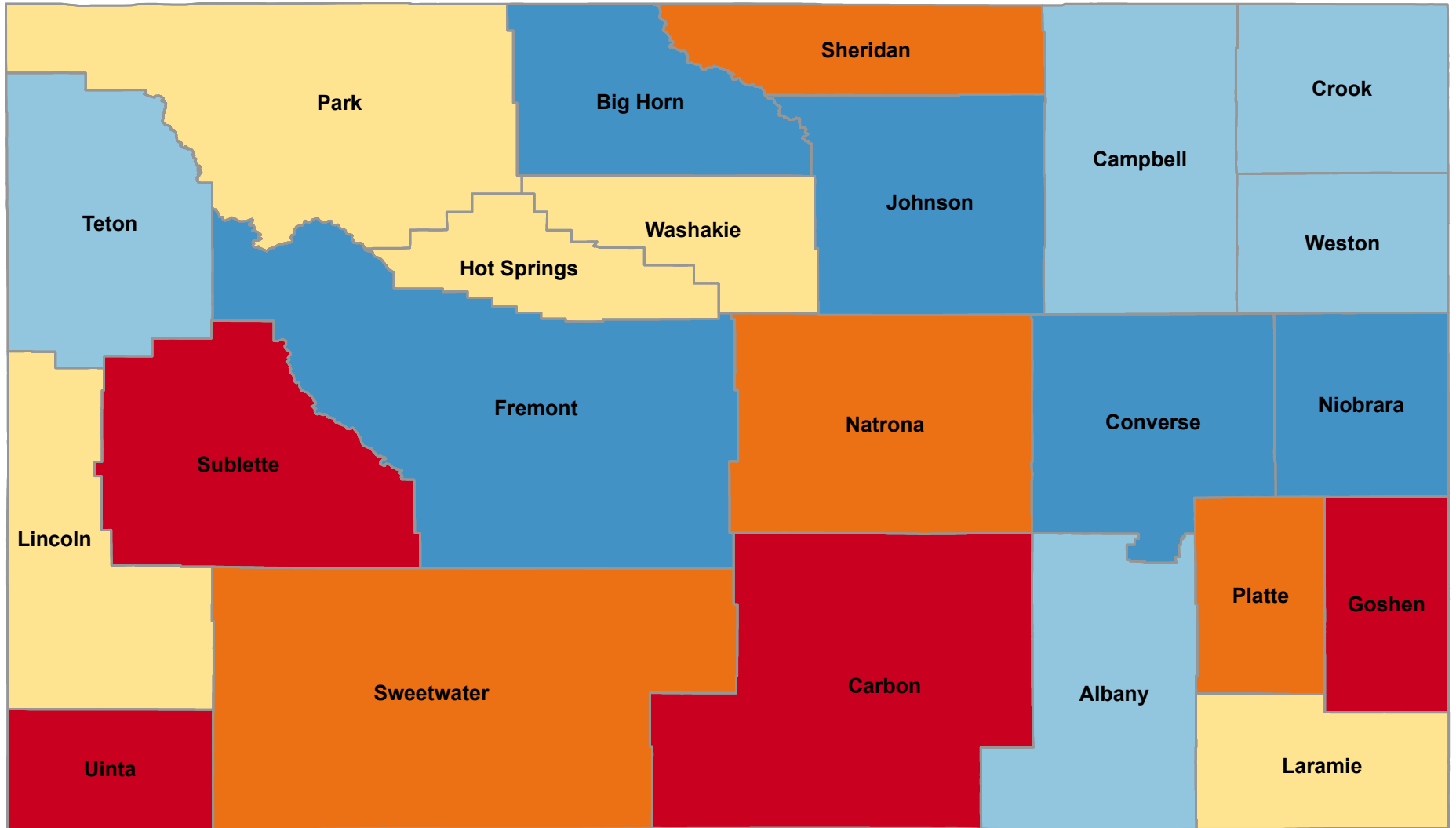
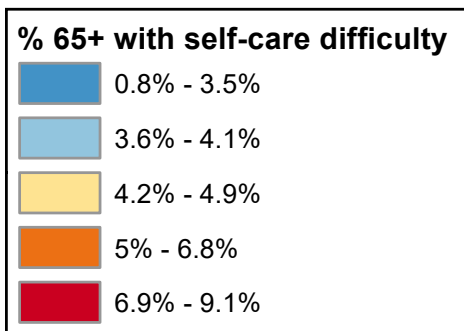


Percentage of Population Age 65+ Years with Self-Reported Self-Care Difficulty
