Plainfield (Sullivan)

Plainfield is a town in Sullivan County with 518 residents aged 65 or older. Compared to state average rates, older residents fare better on some healthy aging indicators with lower rates of high cholesterol, chronic kidney disease, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), hypertension, and tobacco use disorder. However, they have higher rates of cataract, fibromyalgia/chronic pain/fatigue, osteoporosis, and depression. Older residents in Sullivan County vary in obtaining preventive health screenings: residents 18 and older got annual physical exams (71.9%) and annual dental exams (64.1%), while 51.4% of men and 42.5% of women 65 and older completed all CDC recommended vaccinations and cancer screenings. Community resources to support healthy aging include two public libraries.
